# Tennis Guidance - Updated 3/07/20

## Bookings

- In addition to not being able to book more than 3 consecutive court slots, members may not book more than 9 slots in a rolling 7 days. (The only exception is the ability to book any spare slots available on the day).
- All bookings must be fulfilled. The courts will be monitored and any persistent instances of 'no shows' spotted will result in a temporary suspension of booking rights. So please cancel in advance to give others the chance to use slots you cannot utilise.
- It is helpful to all to be adaptable as to when you play early morning or late evening, for example
- School age children must act just as responsibly and it is a parental duty to achieve this.

## Arriving and moving around the club grounds

- No one who is self-isolating or feeling unwell should enter the grounds
- Social distancing at 2 metres or more must be maintained at all times
- Only enter the grounds from the car park
- There is no access to the clubhouse, other than to use the unisex toilet or retrieve the defibrillator. Access is via the side door adjacent to court 1.
- You will meet signage prohibiting members entering without a booking there is no 'turn up and hope to play'
- Unless you have your own hand sanitiser, proceed around the pavilion to the outdoor sink. You should wash your hands for a full 20 seconds with soap and water, or alternatively to use hand sanitiser. There are gloves available for the non-playing hand
- At the end of your session wash or sanitise your hands and promptly return to the car park and leave the club.

### **Conduct on Court**

- Place your tennis bags at least 3 metres apart from any other player
- It is recommended that each server uses their own set of balls
- Change ends via your respective net posts
- Brush court at the end of your session
- Remove any tissues and litter from the court and dispose of in bins or take home.

### Enforcement

- This is a change to our playing habits so behaving infallibly is difficult. That said the rules above are simple enough to follow. All members should uphold the rules and politely alert anyone who is not doing so
- Flagrant violation of these rules will be followed up which may result in being barred from using the club.

• The General Manager, the coaches and anyone delegated by him will be positioned in the club room with a good view of most of the courts and will have total authority to enforce these rules
